Week 6: Goldilocks & the Three Bears Build It: Three Gummy Bears Science Lab

Step 1: Set up your Experiment

- MAKE 3 LABELS TO IDENTIFY THE LIQUIDS IN EACH PLASTIC CUP: WATER, SALT WATER, AND VINEGAR
- POUR 1/4 CUP WATER INTO THE 1ST AND 2ND CUPS. POUR 1/4 CUP VINEGAR (ANY TYPE) INTO THE 3RD CUP
- MAKE A SALT WATER SOLUTION BY MIXING 2 TEASPOONS OF SALT INTO THE 2ND CUP. STIR UNTIL THE SALT DISSOLVES. IT'S OK FOR A LITTLE SALT TO BE LEFT IN THE BOTTOM.
- ADD 1 GUMMY BEAR TO EACH CUP. LEAVE 3 BEARS IN THE BAGGIE FOR COMPARISON. DON'T EAT THEM (YET!)

Step 2: Make your Hypothesis

 A HYPOTHESIS IS YOUR BEST GUESS ABOUT WHAT WILL HAPPEN DURING AN EXPERIMENT. WHAT DO YOU GUESS WILL HAPPEN TO EACH BEAR IN YOUR SCIENCE LAB?

Step 3: Wait and Watch

- CHECK ON YOUR GUMMY BEARS IN 1-2 HOURS (MAYBE SET A TIMER SO YOU'LL REMEMBER). WHAT CAN YOU DO WHILE YOU WAIT? MAYBE READ AND ADD YOUR MINUTES TO YOUR SUMMER READING LOG ON THE BEANSTACK APP?
- CHECK ON YOUR THREE BEARS. WHAT DO YOU SEE?
- REPEAT WAIT ANOTHER 1-2 HOURS AND CHECK ON THE THREE BEARS. ANY CHANGES?
- AFTER SEVERAL HOURS REMOVE THE BEARS FROM THE CUPS AND PLACE THEM ON THE CORRECT LABEL. TAKE
 THE THREE BEARS FROM YOUR BAGGIE AND PLACE ONE ON EACH LABEL FOR COMPARISON.
- WHAT DO YOU SEE? ARE THE BEARS BIGGER, SMALLER, OR THE SAME AS THE GUMMY BEARS FROM THE BAGGIE? DID ANY OF THE BEARS DISSOLVE, OR GET SOFTER OR HARDER? WAS YOUR HYPOTHESIS CORRECT? FLIP THIS CARD OVER TO LEARN MORE ABOUT THE SCIENCE OF THE GUMMY BEARS SCIENCE LAB!
- IF IT'S OK WITH YOUR PARENTS (PLEASE ASK THEM!) YOU MAY EAT THE THREE GUMMY BEARS FROM THE BAGGIE! DO NOT EAT THE BEARS FROM THE CUPS! THEY WILL TASTE NASTY!

Week 6: Goldilocks & the Three Bears Build It: Three Gummy Bears Science Lab

The Science Behind the Gummy Bear Science Lab

Did you guess the Gummy Bear would dissolve?

WHILE MOST SUGARY CANDY DISSOLVES IN LIQUID, GUMMY BEARS ARE ALSO MADE WITH GELATIN WHICH PREVENTS THE BEARS FROM DISSOLVING QUICKLY. INSTEAD THE GUMMY BEARS ALLOWS LIQUID TO PASS INTO IT THROUGH TEENY TINY GAPS. THAT PROCESS IS CALLED OSMOSIS.

Os-what? What is osmosis and what does it have to do with these Bears?

OSMOSIS IS THE PROCESS WHEN A LIQUID MOVES FROM ONE PLACE TO ANOTHER - FROM A GREATER CONCENTRATION TO A LESSER CONCENTRATION. HERE'S HOW OSMOSIS IS GOING ON IN EACH CUP:

- WATER: A GUMMY BEAR DOESN'T CONTAIN MUCH WATER, SO THE PLAIN WATER PASSES INTO THE GUMMY BEAR. THIS MAKES THE BEAR SWELL UP WITH THE WATER AND GROW!
- SALT WATER: A GUMMY BEAR DOESN'T CONTAIN ANY SALT. SO THE SALT PASSES INTO THE GUMMY BEAR AT A HIGHER RATE THAN THE WATER IN THE SALT WATER. SO IT REALLY DOESN'T GROW VERY MUCH. IT MAY EVEN GET HARDER DUE TO THE SOLID NATURE OF THE SALT PARTICLES. WHAT HAPPENED TO YOURS?
- VINEGAR: A GUMMY BEAR DOESN'T CONTAIN VINEGAR EITHER SO IT ALSO WILL ALSO GROW. IN THE BEGINNING. HOWEVER, VINEGAR IS ALSO AN ACID. IN TIME THE ACID WILL START TO DISSOLVE THE GELATIN AND THE GUMMY WILL START TO FALL APART. DID YOURS GROW? DID IT START TO FALL APART? TRY PUTTING IT BACK IN THE VINEGAR OVERNIGHT AND SEE WHAT HAPPENS.




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
Week 6: Goldilocks & the Three Bears Craft It: Make Goldilocks & Bear Paper Bag Puppets




Instructions:

- Color and cut out the puppet pieces each puppet has a head and a body
- Place one paper bag so the bottom of the bag is facing up
- Glue the face onto what would be the bottom section of the bag
- Glue the body onto the long, vertical part of the bag
- Put your hand inside and make the puppet's head move and pretend it can talk! What would it say? The porridge is too hot?
- Repeat with the other characters
- Act out the Goldilocks story or make up one of your own!








Papa Bear Puppet
