Historical Note

The American Legion is a veteran's organization. Organized by American soldiers in France following World War I, the organization was chartered by the United States Congress in 1919. Although a national organization, the Legion is comprised of local chapters, or posts. The Sudbury American Legion, post 191, was organized in 1919. Shortly after the local chapter was founded, the town approved use of the old Wadsworth School building as the Legion's meeting hall. As a veteran's organization, the Sudbury Legion provides services to local veterans and the broader community. These services include: providing a social community for veterans, advocating for legislation, organizing scholarships, and helping the town commemorate holidays like Memorial Day. Today, the local post is still active at its current location along Boston Post Road in Sudbury.

Scope and Content

The collection consists of materials related to the planning and management of the Sudbury chapter of the American Legion. Materials include meeting minutes, newsletters, membership forms, financial records, and correspondence. These materials provide insight into the needs and interests of veterans of both World War I and World War II, and also highlight activities of various community organizations from the town of Sudbury. The collection is arranged in two series.
